I received 1997 dataset for Bangladesh but I noticed that weight of children are not in correct format. The description said 1 decimal. I am not sure what that means.
For example a child is 63 kg and 115 cm and there are many more.
Can you please clarify?
Did they mean 6.3 kg ?

Following is a response from Senior DHS Stata Specialist, Tom Pullum:
