On the website it's stated that surveys are generally representative at the national, regional and place of residence (urban vs rural) level. Is this true also for the case of Haiti? I'm wondering whether creating 21 strata (urban and rural for each of the 10 regions plus Port-au-Prince) allows me to compare urban and rural areas at the regional level.

For instance, can I infer anything about the access to electricity for urban households across regions? Or can I say anytying only at the national level, comparing urban and rural households?
