Quote:You are using SPSS and I only work with Stata, so I cannot give you SPSS code. In Stata correct steps would be as follows. You want to merge on the household id code, which is whhid in the WI file and is the first 12 characters of caseid in the IR file. I hope than in SPSS you know a way to extract the first 12 characters of caseid.

use e:\DHS\DHS\_data\WR\_files\PKWR21FL.dta, clear sort whhid save e:\DHS\DHS\_data\scratch\PKWRtemp.dta, replace

use e:\DHS\DHS\_data\IR\_files\PKIR21FL.dta, clear gen whhid=substr(caseid,1,12) sort whhid merge whhid using e:\DHS\DHS\_data\scratch\PKWRtemp.dta tab \_merge keep if \_merge==3 drop \_merge
