I am using the Namibian DHS 2013. I created one file with women's, men's and HIV data. I want to calculate the percentage of people aged 15-49 years, who have heard of AIDS, by background characteristics. I got the same frequencies as in the Namibian final report 2013. But I am not sure if the p-values may be true. For example by residence the p-value for women is significant and for men not, although there are no great differences. I load up a part of my results.
