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Dear User,

I looked at the Standard Recode Manual for DHS II and found the following regarding the CASEID:

Quote:

Case identification used to uniquely identify each respondent. In most surveys this is constructed by concatenating the cluster or sample point number, the household number and the respondent's line number, but in some surveys this may be the questionnaire number taken from the front page of the questionnaire.

For V002 I found the following:

Quote:

V002 Household number is the number identifying the household in which the respondent was interviewed, within the sample point. In some cases, this variable may be the combination of dwelling number and household number within dwelling. In these cases, the original variables are included as country-specific variables.
