Thank you very much for confirming that information, it was most helpful.

I just wanted to follow up on the third point and whether someone could please let me know how this was calculated? I also have another question - could you please confirm how the sub-sample of domestic violence was implemented?

On page 241 of the 2011 Uganda DHS report section 16.1.2 it says that in the 1/3 of households selected for the men's survey, 1 eligible man per household took the domestic violence module, and in the remaining 2/3 households 1 woman took the domestic violence module. Further down the page in section 16.1.3 it says that the domestic violence module was implemented only in the subsample of households selected for the men's survey. Could you please confirm whether the domestic violence module was implemented to all households (of which 1/3 were to men and 2/3 were to women) or whether it was only in the households in which the men's survey was implemented (of which 1/3 were to men and 2/3 were to women)?
