Following is a response from Senior DHS Stata Specialist, Tom Pullum:

The newest surveys, including the Ethiopia 2016 DHS, include day of birth, as well as month and year. This permits a more exact definition of "the past two years". The cdc (century day code) of the interview is v008a. The cdc of the birth of the most recent child is b18_01. The condition for being in table 9.12, that is, for a birth in the past two years, is $v008a - b18_01 \leq 730$. The weighted number of births satisfying this condition is 4308.
