These variables are located within the household. Most are country specific. You will want to take a look at your frequencies and look at variables which start with SH. You will also want to take a look at the document called EGIR61.doc. This document was distributed with the data and contains a list of all the country specific variables in the data set along with their labels. It will be useful if you also take a look at the questionnaires (located in one of the Appendices in the report).
