Dear User, You can start by looking at P40 of the Standard Recode6 manual. B0 is the variable for multiple births.

Quote:

Twin code gives an order number for each child of a multiple birth. Code 0 indicates a single birth, code 1-upwards give the number of the child. Twins are ordered in the birth history with the higher twin codes appearing before the lower twin codes.
