I am using NFHS4 India, looking at acute respiratory symptoms. If this survey uses questionnaire recode VI for ARI, should I use the old definition, which includes cough, i. e:

$ari=1 \text{ if } h31==2 \ \& \ (h31b = 1 \ \& \ h31c==3/1)$

Or should I use the new one, without cough?

$ari=1 \text{ if } H31B == 1 \ \& \ (H31C ==1 \ | \ H31C == 3)$

I wonder it that matter considering how the survey was applied.
