Note that the misconceptions are survey specific. In the example given, the code assumes that the two most common misconceptions are: the AIDS virus can be transmitted by mosquito bites and a person can become infected by sharing food with a person who has AIDS. However, the misconceptions must be verified for each survey, and the two most common are used. Note that some survey specific misconceptions are included in a few surveys too.
