I have recently calculated BMI of Bangladeshi women with Asian cut-off [23.5 kg/m² increased risk; and 27.5 kg/m² or higher high risk.]
But, my supervisor told me to calculate those BMI with WHO cut-off (International) i.e., 25 kg/m² or higher as overweight.

Now, Can anybody help me by answering that, "Why international but not Asian cut-off have to be used to calculate BMI of Bangladeshi women?"?
