I get the following result: not matched: 337,481 from master 49,203 from using: 288,278

matched: 229,101

The household dataset has 517,379 observations The individual dataset has 90,582 observation

Does this mean that from my master (individual) file, only (90,582-49,203) 41,379 individuals are not matched to a household; meaning I cannot use them in my further analysis?
