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Hello,

You can compute age-specific fertility rates by religion, and from them compute mean age at childbearing.

With Stata, you can use the `tfr2` command, that will compute age-specific fertility rates, TFR and mean age at childbearing (with the `mac` option). For instance, if you type

```
by v130, sort : tfr2, mac
```

You will have age-specific fertility rates, TFR and MAC by religion.

This works fine with the latest DHS in India, but you should be careful to use the correct all-women factors when computing age-specific fertility rates with previous surveys, when they were conducted among ever married women. I did not check if all-women factors are available by religion; if not, you can compute them from the household data.
