I will assume you are using the IR file. In century month codes, the month of the survey is v008, the mother's birth month is v011, and the month of her most recent birth is  $b_01$  (if she has never given birth, then  $b_01=$ .). Her age in years at the time of the survey is int((v008-v011)/12). Her age at the time of the most recent birth is  $int((b_01-v011)/12)$ .
