BCG, Polio and DTP are considered for children 12-23 months and measles is considered for children 24-35 months. How does the code change based on this categorization?

I assume that is why on Table 11.3 pg 149 in the final report (https://dhsprogram.com/pubs/pdf/FR341/FR341.pdf), all basic vaccinations for 12-23 months is N/A?
