I only have STATA and I was able to make stata read the .sav files that I retrieved from the Turkish institute (as opposed to DHS, the Turkish institution only sent the .sav extension files). Because I don't have SPSS I wanted to learn from you which variables you managed to get using SPSS. If the variables that I am looking for are already not available even with the SPSS version, I would not try to find the SPSS program. For example, "ethnicity (v131)", "currently residing with a husband (v504)" or "respondent employed all year/seasonal (v732)" have no observations which don't seem right.
