## Dear User,

The blood pressure measurement variables are country specific variables. However, they can be easily found by checking the map file, which was distributed with your downloaded dataset. All country specific variables begin with the letter "S" and usually are named similarly to the variable in the raw data (or your questionnaire). For example: Q101ESN is country specific variable S101ES in the recoded data file. This is the variable for the systolic measurement. Below are the variables for the women and men indicating the systolic and diastolic.

Blood pressure was measured several times during the interview:

Women S101ES = Q101ESN; systolic S101ED = Q101EDN; diastolic S564S = Q564SN; systolic S564D = Q564DN; diastolic S1027S = Q1027SN; systolic S1027D = Q1027SN; diastolic

Men SM101ES = QM101ESN; systolic SM101ED = QM101EDN; diastolic SM442S = QM442SN; systolic SM442D = QM442DN; diastolic SM831S = QM831SN; systolic SM831D = QM831SN; diastolic
