The codes go from 1 to 37 but for some reason code 26 is skipped, so there are only 36 distinct values, as there should be, because India has 36 states. I will also attach the unweighted number of cases in the IR or women's file in the NFHS-5. You refer to 158 or 64 observations, but you must be talking about the distribution of some variable that only applies to a small part of the population.
