Following is a response from DHS staff member, Tom Pullum:

A single file that includes both the women and men would be constructed with the "append" command. The following Stata lines should do this:

\* Define a workspace cd e:\DHS\DHS\_data\scratch

use ...COMR71FL.dta, clear gen sex=1 label define sex 1 "Male" 2 "Female" label values sex sex

\* Rename variables in the MR file to match the names on the IR file \* As a minimum, this will include the mv variables but there may be others rename mv\* v\* save COMR71temp.dta, replace

use ...COIR72FL.dta, clear gen sex=2 append using COMR71temp.dta

save COIRMR.dta, replace

If you want a merged file, in which a woman and man in the same household are combined as a couple, you should just use the CR ("couples") file. You do not actually need to do that merge--it has already been done for you.
