Following is a response from DHS staff member, Tom Pullum:

We checked with Guillermo Rojas, the DHS staff member most familiar with all of the Colombia surveys. Here is his response: "The 554 NA cases correspond to respondents for whom privacy was not possible. In question 1001 interviewers record whether there was privacy at the time of starting the "Gender Violence" section. If privacy was not granted the whole section is skipped."

These cases are probably not "missing at random (MAR)" but there are so few of them, in percentage terms, that analyses based on the non-missing cases will have a negligible bias.
