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Here's a response from one of our experts, Shawna Kelly:

HML10 is referencing the section RECHML: Malaria: By Mosquito Bednet. To reproduce the information in table 3.9 of the final report, you'll need to use variables in the section RECHMH Malaria: By Household Member and RECH1: Household schedule. Instead of HML10, you'll want to look at HML12.
