I easily replicated the results of the other age groups (0-5 years and women 15-49 years). In the 2005 DHS of Egypt, hemoglobin data was also collected but for the 10-19 years and I can replicate the results as well. The problem is with the adolescents in the Egypt 2000 DHS.
