Here is a response from one of our data processing experts, Mr. Nouredine Abderrahim:

Quote:As you can see in table 4.3 in Pakistan DHS 2012-13 (Age at first marriage) that there is a column percentage never married. The survey in Pakistan 2012-13 DHS includes only ever-married women. So where this information come from? The answer is that an adjustment is made, to include the missing never-married women, called all women factor. The explanation and the use of the all women factors is explained in the DHS Guide to Statistics (starting on page 18).
