Dear User.

HV216 is a standard recode variable but was not asked in the 2001 Nepal DHS survey. The question "Do the members of your household work in their own or family's agricultural land?" was also not asked in the Household questionnaire. Q611 in the individual woman's questionnaire was "Do you work mainly on your own land or on family land, or do you work on land that you rent from someone else, or do you work on someone else's land?" This was asked of respondents who work in agriculture. The question also appears in the man's questionnaire and is QM606. Recode variables for Q611 is V740 (woman), for QM606 is MV740 (man
