use e:\DHS\DHS_data\BR_files\CIBR61FL.dta, clear keep if b16>0 & b16<98 sort v001 v002 v003 b16 save e:\DHS\DHS_data\scratch\temp1.dta, replace

gen sibs_in_hh=1

collapse (sum) sibs_in_hh, by(v001 v002 v003) replace sibs_in_hh=sibs_in_hh-1 tab sibs_in_hh,m

sort v001 v002 v003 merge v001 v002 v003 b16 using e:\DHS\DHS_data\scratch\temp1.dta

tab _merge tab sibs_in_hh,m drop _merge

* This file will include the number of siblings (children with the same mother) who are living in the same

* household, WITH THE MOTHER. Siblings who are not living with the mother will be much harder to identify.

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
