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We do not have code for the original definition written in Stata. I am attaching a file that includes the CSPro code that is used for the construction of 3 definitions of unmet need found in v624, v626, and v626a. This code refers to definition 1, definition 2, and definition 3. Definition 2 is the

"Original" version and definition 3 is the "Updated" version. Strictly speaking there was an earlier version (definition 1) than the "original" version, but this was replaced by the "original" version a long time ago. Hopefully the CSPro code will provide enough information for you to be able to construct Stata code.
