Unit of analysis Households: hv005 Household members: hv005 Women: v005 Children: v005 Men: mv005 Domestic Violence: d005 HIV test results: hiv05

You need to divide the sampling weight by 1,000,000.

Examples:

In Stata: generate wgt = v005/1000000 tab var [iweight=wgt]

In SPSS: COMPUTE WGT = V005/1000000. WEIGHT by WGT.
