The all-women factors are only needed for surveys that are limited to ever-married women (EMW), and they include a factor of 100. For all-women surveys, the variables you list are included, but they are set to 100 for all cases. That means you don't need to use them. The India surveys include all women. They are not limited to EMWs.
