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Following is a response from DHS staff member Tom Pullum:

In Stata there is a family of estimation commands "teffects" that includes "teffects psmatch" for propensity score matching. We have used that method in a few Analytical Studies but those reports did not go into the details of the Stata code. We can't help with the syntax of the command but the online Stata manual should give everything you need to know (<https://www.stata.com/manuals/teteffectspsmatch.pdf>) .
