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Dear User,

If you are looking at a frequency of HV018, the codes indicate the codes which were assigned to the interviewers. Those codes for all intents and purposes uniquely identify the interviewers.

HV018 for the household questionnaire and V028 for the individual questionnaire. In most cases these should be the same code as we expect an interviewer to interview the household and all the individuals within that household.

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Am I right in understanding that using only the variable hv018 identifies a single interviewer.

I.e, that there were exactly 100 interviewers for DHS in whole India, with some interviewing as little as 2 households and others more than 3000 ?

That sounds surprising to me (but I of course could be wrong), which is why I believe hv018 needs to be combined with other identifiers (for exemple state and/or district) to attribute a unique ID to a unique interviewer.

If the latter is correct, could you tell with which other variables I should combine hv018 in order to create a variable that would take a unique value for a unique interviewer ?
