The number of births in the past year is v209. You can get approximately what you want with the following lines in Stata:

```
gen v201_one_year_ago=v201-v209
```

```
gen birth_in_past_year=v209
```

```
replace birth_in_past_year=1 if v209>1
```

```
tab v201_one_year_ago v013, summarize(birth_in_past_year) means obs
```

This will give a table with the proportion of women of women who had a birth in the past year, tabulated by parity at the beginning of that year and age group (at the time of the survey). This command does not include weights. You can use `svyset` and `svy` to get weights. Hope this will meet your needs or you can modify it.
