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My name is Michelle, and I am currently working with the Benin 2017-18 DHS Household Recode dataset to caculate a key education indicator: the percentage of children of compulsory schooling age who are currently not enrolled.

Denominator: All children who fall within the compulsory schooling age range(to be defined based on Benin's official policy)

Numerator: Children who are both within the compulsory schooling age range AND currently not in school.

I initially planned to use two variables from the Household Recode dataset to compute this indicator:

hv105(Age of household members)-to identify children of compulsory schooling age; hv110(is the household member still in school)-to determine enrollment status

However, after loading the dataset into Stata, I noticed that all values for the variable hv110 are displayed as '.'. I am writing to seek your guidance on two questions:

- 1. Could you help explain what these universal missing values for hv110 indicate?
- 2. If hv110 is not availabe or fully missing for this dataset, could you recommend alternative variables within the Household Recode dataser that I can use to identify the enrollment satus of children?
