Below is an example of appending two "KR" data files from two different Kenya DHS survey using SPSS.

*Opening data file.

```
GET FILE='C:\DHSSurvey\KEKR31FL.SAV'.
```

*Appending a second file.

```
ADD FILES /FILE=*
```

```

```
  /IN=source01.
```

```
VARIABLE LABELS source01
```

```
