Unfortunately our standard DHS tables, and the data in STATcompiler, cannot be disaggregated by both urban-rural residence and region. If you are comfortable working with our datasets in an analysis software like SAS, STATA, or SPSS, you could register to download the full dataset and see if you have enough rural cases in Lusaka District to get your indicator data.
