If you are using Stata, it is quite easy: <http://www.stata.com/help.cgi?append>

- 1) Open one of the files
- 2) type "append using 'filename1'"
- 3) type "append using 'filename2'"

And you are done. You will, though, have to de-normalize the weights at some point if you plan to use them. You can see a number of threads on the forum about how to do that.
