In the country-level questions- there are columns "ssubd" and "svillage" and the answers are numbers. Is there a list somewhere indicating what locations those numbers stand for? I noticed this in both the 2012 and 2007 survey, and we are interested in subregional information for all years of the Indonesia survey.

Also, in order to protect respondent confidentiality, we are not able to provide geographic identifiers for any levels lower than the second administrative level.
