The Rwanda DHS 2007-08 was an interim survey. It did not have all the sections of a normal DHS. I checked the final report on our website <http://www.dhsprogram.com/publications/publication-FR215-DHS-Final-Reports.cfm> and there was no HIV section. If you look at the questionnaire in Appendix E for the woman and the man, you will see those questions were not asked.
