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To view whether a survey has GPS data available, please refer to <http://www.measuredhs.com/data/available-datasets.cfm>. GPS data was not collected as part of the India 2005-06 survey. Therefore, the only spatial data available for the India 2005-06 survey is at the DHS regions level, and is available for download in shapefile or geodatabase format from <http://spatialdata.measuredhs.com/>.

For the India 1992-93 and 1998-99 surveys, there are district-level classifications available at <http://userforum.measuredhs.com/index.php?t=msg&th=232&start=0&>. The district-level classifications are not available for the 2005-06 survey due to confidentiality requirements of HIV testing.

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
