These variables are country specific.

Q411 = S411; is a single numeric variable.

Q412 and Q413 are alphanumeric and recoded as numeric single variables to capture all the information from the alphanumeric variables.

For example: for Q412 there would be 13 separate variables as S412A - S412K, S412X, S412Z for Q413 there would be 14 separate variables as S413A - S413M, S413X

These variables start with an "S". Hope this helps. Thank you!
