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I am using the Tanzania and Senegal women's database (IR) and I don't find observations for variables such as "can refuse sex" and "can ask partner to use a condom". On the other hand, for South Africa and Tanzania i don't find observations for women's religion (v130). So I want to confirm that these variables are not available in this survey.

In addition, in the Benin database, I observe many missing values (app. 45%) for the women's sexual power variables (v850a and v850b).
