The calculation of the mortality estimates in DHS surveys is described in the Guide to DHS Statistics <http://www.dhsprogram.com/publications/publication-dhsg1-dhs-questi-onnaires-and-manuals.cfm> pages 90-94, so you can see if your approach differs from the DHS standard approach.
