- 2> For the same HH ID, (hv002), I see that I have different division and cluster data which cannot be right as the same HH cannot be in separate divisions. Can someone kindly clarify this? 3> Is there a better way of getting men's and women's data, maybe using the couple's module? In the BDHS couple's module, the violence data is missing even though it is not missing in the IR module.
