Following is a response from Senior DHS Stata Specialist, Tom Pullum:

It appears that the questions about antibiotics were asked with options for specific types and these are coded in separate variables, not with h37i or h37j. In the Bangladesh survey, for example, they are given in the KR file with 7 variables s538g through s538m. I found them by entering the command "lookfor antib", which searches through variable lables. You could do the same for the India and Myanmar KR files.

However, in India I can only find overall information of antibiotic use i.e antibiotic taken via any method (oral /injection). That is variable "ml13n". The other variables got no observations (h37i, h37j, ml13i and ml13j). It would be great if I could get the detailed information by route of administration. Could you also help me with this?
