It is recorded in days, months, and years in the questionnaires. You can look at Angola MIS 2006, Angola MIS 2011, Kenya MIS 2010, Liberia MIS 2009, Nigeria MIS 2010, Senegal MIS 2008-09, Tanzania DHS-MIS 2015-16, Uganda MIS 2009.
