- 1) On the Home page, under Tools and Resources, click on Survey Search
- 2) Click on the drop-down menu for survey type
- 3) Check the boxes for Standard DHS and Continuous DHS
- 4) Click on the Search button

This will give you a list of surveys and years. For the most part, all these surveys should have vaccination data, including measles.
