- 3. Knows numbers 1 to 10 (sec13)

For Physical development

- 4. Pick up small object from ground (sec14)
- 5. Sometimes too sick to play (sec15)

For Learning/cognition development

- 6. Follows simple directions (sec16)
- 7. Able to do something independently (sec17)

For Socioemotional Development

- 8. Gets along with other children (sec18)
- 9. Kicks, bites, hits other children (sec19)
- 10. Is easily distracted (reverse coded) (sec20)
