This can be tricky to construct on your own, and that's why it's one of the standard recode files prepared by DHS.

When you do a merge, Stata constructs a variable called "\_merge". Note the underscore before the word. Its values are mainly 1, 2, 3 and are defined in "help merge". You need a line "drop \_merge" before you do a second merge.
