You can calculate perinatal mortality using code available on the DHS GitHub website. This indicator is in Chapter 8 which covers Child Mortality. You will need to run the code from the CMmain.do file. Please do not try to run the CM.PMR.do file separately which contains the code for perinatal mortality. Basic instructions include changing the paths and the survey file name in the main file.
